

The simulation has been accepted for review by SAMHSA's National Registry of Evidence-based Programs and Practices (NREPP). A study with 425 health professionals shows that it results in statistically significant increases in skills to identify risk factors, screen patients, discuss treatment options, engage in collaborative decision-making, and build intrinsic motivation in patients to adhere to a treatment plan.
